- This week, visit one of the art spaces listed below.
- Please make sure the art space is open during a time you can visit.
- Using neutral terms, describe one artwork on display. Write at least 15 terms per category: Point, Line, Shape, Texture, Value, Color, Unity, Variety, Balance, Proportion, Scale, Rhythm, & Emphasis. These are the terms from Chapters 1 & 3 from *Launching the Imagination*. You can refer to the list of descriptive terms that we created in class.
- We suggest to choose an artwork you strongly like or dislike.
- Photograph the artwork and include the image at the top of the page.
- Record all the artwork information: Artist Name, Artwork Title, Materials, Date, Dimensions (Size), and where it is exhibited (Art Space name).
- Final Formal Analysis Lists should be typed in a legible 12-point font.

Write 15 lists of descriptive terms, one list for each category, for the artwork you have chosen. Use any and all descriptive terms that fit your artwork. Each category should have at least 15 descriptive terms.

Your list should be typed, printed, and include: your name and all of the artwork information (artist name, artwork title, materials, date, dimensions (size), and where it was exhibited).
